BEST KEP T VILLAGE COMPETITION 2019

Results of the 2019 competition were recently announced at the annual award ceremony. In the large village class Longton was Highly Commended, just missing out on one of the top two awards.

New Longton Cricket Club were placed third in the outstanding cricket club section awards whilst pride of place goes to Blundells of Longton who were awarded first place in the outstanding shops category. In a highly competitive section of 23 entries Blundells were indeed an outstanding entry and well deserved the award and certificate that they received at the awards ceremony.

NEW OVERFLOW CAR PARK OPENS

The Parish Council are pleased to be able to open up the new overflow car park at Longton Victory Memorial Recreation Ground. Funded from Parish Council monies and funds received from the Community Infrastructure Levy the new surface should prove to be more resilient than the previous mesh that had been laid. It is hoped that the facilities will be used by all residents, not just those using the recreation ground facilities, and that in this way it will reduce some of the parking issues around the immediate area.

LONGTON FETE 2019



The proceeds of the ever popular dog show went to Guide Dogs with prizes for dogs in nine categories supplied by Superpet Warehouse who must be thanked for their ongoing sponsorship. MARSH LANE NATURE CONSERVATION AMPHIBIAN PROJECT



This project involves the recording of information on all amphibian movements and is undertaken by volunteers in late winter to early spring. The scheme has been running in Longton since 2009 and is part of the established nationwide 'Toads on Roads' monitoring scheme, which has

been going now for over 20 years. The information is crucial in helping national efforts to conserve Common Toads which have declined in recent years and have priority status in the UK Biodiversity Framework. The volunteers monitor and record amphibian movements as the animals appear on consistently warm nights, when they are most active. Common Toads are very particular about where they breed and often migrate back to their ancestral breeding ponds each year. They follow the same route, regardless of what gets in their way, which sometimes leads to them crossing roads. Marsh Lane is one of those roads which has a defined 'Toad Crossing'. The 'Toads on Roads' project registers these sites and helps coordinate local Toad Patrols. LCC provided local volunteers with luminous jackets for monitoring after dark and also temporary road signs to help make motorists aware and help protect these animals.
