The meeting was adjourned

Representation was made concerning planning application 07/2020/01063/FUL as follows:

- 1. Concerns with regard to the access through from School Lane which is already congested and has the primary school close to the location. It is considered to be an inappropriate access and that access should be from the far side of the proposed development by the creation of a new access road.
- 2. The location of the proposed flats in close proximity to existing dwellings is not appropriate since it will create a loss of privacy, overshadowing and be totally out of keeping with the area.
- 3. The traffic movements suggested in the application cause concern as they do not reflect the number of vehicles likely to belong to the residents of the properties and are at odds with the provision of 93 parking places.

07/2020/01026/HOH-Proposed two storey extension to front and rear with part cladding of existing dwelling @ Hawkstone Royalty Lane New Longton PR4 4JE

07/2020/01063/FUL – Erection of 33 new residential units with associated garages and works, and new access from Reynard Close @ Land to the east of Reynard Close Longton

It was resolved that the following representation should be made regarding 07/2020/01063/FUL and that this Council must object to the proposals as they currently stand.

- 1. Concerns with regard to the access through from School Lane which is already congested and has the primary school close to the location. It is considered to be an inappropriate access and that access should be from the far side of the proposed development by the creation of a new access road something that was raised during consultation when this site was proposed to be included into the Local Plan.
- 2. The location of the proposed flats in close proximity to existing dwellings is not appropriate since it will create a loss of privacy, overshadowing and be totally out of keeping with the area. It is suggested that either

these flats are relocated to the far side of the development adjacent to open fields or are completely removed, in either case a complete redesign of the proposed development should be undertaken.

- 3. The traffic movements suggested in the application cause concern as they do not reflect the number of vehicles likely to belong to the residents of the properties and are at odds with the provision of 93 parking places. The provision of 93 car parking spaces would suggest a greater number of vehicular movements at peak times than is suggested by the applicants consultants.
- 4. In addition it is unclear as to whether there is any provision made for affordable housing. The development must meet current Local Plan guidelines in this respect.
